As a specialist health care service for people with a Learning Disability in North Derbyshire, we are commissioned to respond to health needs directly related to or arising from a person's Learning Disability. Our primary base is at Ash Green but we provide services across the North of the county

Aims

To support/supplement access to universal health services where specialist input is required

To provide a service that is broad based, flexible and focused on the individual's requirements and in line with Government and local legislation

To deliver a quality, person centred, multi disciplinary service, tailored to the individual's assessed need, within a risk management framework

To promote social inclusion

Referrals

Referrals can be received from any professional/carer or you can self refer

Criteria for referral

Adults (aged 18 or over) with a Learning Disability which impacts on their ability to access universal services and requires specialist support

Speech and Language Therapy

We work in a person centred way with individuals and carers to enable communication in the best way for them and to ensure safe eating, drinking and swallowing

Psychology

We provide tailored assessment, intervention and support around complex presentations including mental health, behavioural/forensic presentation, capacity abuse, cognitive functioning and dementia

Assessment/Treatment Unit

An inpatient service tailored to meet the needs of adults with a Learning Disability and associated complex needs that can prevent them from accessing universal services to meet their physical or mental health needs

Community Nursing

We facilitate an individual's need to reach optimum mental and physical health e.g. epilepsy, diabetes, bereavement, through assessment and health action planning

Outreach service

We provide a crisis response to individuals during periods of increased health need. Person centred interventions are delivered in partnership with carers and the local community team

Sensory

An environmental approach which stimulates the senses. Aims to identify the cause of difficulties through exploration and intervention in order to enhance quality of life

Psychiatry

Assess, treat and monitor conditions, facilitating a holistic approach to an individual's medical needs

Occupational Therapy

We assess, facilitate and support people to become more independent in all aspects of their life. This is achieved by maximising their function and ability

Short break Services

Our units which are located across North Derbyshire, provide health led services to people with a Learning Disability

Transition

To establish the health needs of a young person 16 - 18yrs, plan multidisciplinary input, in line with the Derbyshire Transition pathway

Physiotherapy

We provide a 24 hour approach to posture care for people with complex physical disability, sensory integration and specialist falls prevention
